Course Description:

Laboratory experience in support of CHM130.
Completion of CHM130LL required for the Natural Science requirement.

Prerequisites:

Prerequisites or Co-requisites: CHM130.
Grade of "C" or better in CHM090, or MAT092, or MAT102, or satisfactory score on placement exam.

OSHA- approved splash-proof safety goggles *ARE* required. **NO GOGGLES = NO LAB No Exceptions!**

Closed-toed shoes and clothing that covers the neck to the knees is required.

There is a 10% deduction from each lab grade for each violation (e.g. – inappropriate clothing, no lab worksheet, etc.)

Attendance:

Regular attendance is an absolute must. If you miss the first day, you will be dropped. Any student missing more than two labs will receive a "W" or "F" for the course per GCC policy. You must stay the full period in order to receive credit for attendance. ***There are NO make-up labs!!! You must come to YOUR lab during the scheduled time.***

If one lab is missed, the final is offered at the end of the semester to make-up the points. You may attend another lab section only twice per semester with both instructor's permission only. This must be done within the same week as your regularly scheduled lab.

If you withdraw from the CHM 130 lecture before June 17th, you must also withdraw from your lab course.

Students may request the W, or the instructor may assign a W to a student for excessive absences prior to June 17th or for being a no-show (not showing up on the first day of class). Students should know that **after June 17th they must request the W in writing or they will be given the grade of F.** It is *your* responsibility as the student to drop the course. Don't assume your instructor will automatically drop you. If you receive financial aide, please consult an advisor before requesting a W.

Grading:

The final course grade will be evaluated based on the following:

Labs: 25 points a piece = 100% of your grade

Final: Only required if you missed a lab

100-90% = A 89-80% = B 79-70% = C 69-60% = D 59-0% = F
